



USA GYMNASTICS 2023 SPIRIT OF THE FLAME NOMINATION FORM

The *Robert Miller Spirit of the Flame Award is given by the USA Gymnastics Athletes' Council to recognize individuals from the sport of gymnastics who have demonstrated leadership, strength and determination in an extraordinary way. It also serves to celebrate both an individual's personal and athletic achievement.

The nominator submitting the name of the nominee for consideration should include any and all pertinent information regarding the nominee that outlines why the individual is worthy of the award. Information should be typed and include examples of the nominee's exemplary qualities within the sport and in life. Recipients of this award are characterized by (but not limited to) personal and athletic accomplishments, dedication, leadership and commitment that positively impact the mission of USA Gymnastics.

Nominators must be an active USA Gymnastics adult member and nominees must be a current or former USA Gymnastics member within the last 10 years. Nominees and nominators must be in good standing with USA Gymnastics. Nominations received will be submitted to the USA Gymnastics Athletes' Council for consideration.
